We are so happy to offer a selection of native plants this spring! There are eight different kits featuring 50 plugs of the Great Lakes Regions, 10 different species per kit. The orders will need to be placed by March 28th and will be delivered here to the office by the first week of June. You will be notified upon their arrival and they will need to be picked up as soon as possible. We hope you will give at least one a try! Adding native plants to your property has SO many benefits to the local food web (this includes pollinators, insects, birds and other wildlife) BEE friendly and plant native plants today!

## SPRING 2025 KIT DESCRIPTIONS

**BASIC PRAIRIE GARDEN—NEW!** The Basic Prairie Garden Kit features a selection of core native species that are fundamental to a native plant garden. The kit includes several key pollinator species which grow in most soil types and prefer full sun. Butterfly weed, Coreopsis, Purple Coneflower, Bee Balm, Black eyed Susan and Rattlesnake Master are included.

**KEYSTONE POLLINATOR KIT - NEW!** This kit is premium and features species that will attract and host pollinators, providing essential food sources and habitat. Because each species included in this kit prefers certain growing conditions, research is needed to insure success. Species include Columbine, Blue False Indigo, Milkweed, Leadplant and Western Sunflower.

**LOW-PROFILE GARDEN—NEW!** The Low-Profile kit features a diverse selection of grasses and forbs that will remain short in stature, not to exceed 3 feet tall. The plants will grow well in sun/part shade and prefer mesic-dry soil. Nodding onion, purple prairie clover, whorled milkweed, Stiff Coreopsis, Prairie Junegrass, Hairy Beardtongue, and Grey Goldenrod included.

**MONARCH GARDEN KIT - NEW!** Three varieties of milkweed provide food and nectar sources for monarch butterflies to thrive. These plants prefer sun/part sun and will grow well in mesic soil (not too dry, not too wet).

**PURPLE RAIN KIT - NEW!** This kit will perform well in an area that would have short-term flooding and temporary drought conditions, so perfect for those rain garden areas! This selection of forbs will bloom in shades of purple, blue and lavender and include Blue False Indigo, Purple coneflower, Southern Blue Flag Iris, purple prairie clover, blue vervain, and blazing star.

**PRAIRIE GRASS KIT** - This kit was offered in the past and includes a mix of deeply rooted grasses and sedges that are low maintenance, will thrive in full sun, and prefer medium to dry soil. Includes Big and Little Bluestem, Switchgrass, Prairie Dropseed June Grass, Side-oats grama, Bottlebrush Grass, Canada Wild Rye, and Indian Grass.

**SHADE KIT** - The Shade kit is a mix of shade loving wildflowers, sedges, and grasses for season long interest. It performs well in shade/part-shade and prefers medium soil. It Includes Great Blue Lobelia, Northern Sea Oats, and Wild Columbine.

**RAIN GARDEN KIT** - Great plants for the rain garden situation! Swamp Milkweed, Common Rush, Golden Alexanders, Bristly and Brown Fox Sedges, Broad leaved Purple Coneflower and Common Mountain Mint are included.
